



## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL



In March 2009, the PMSA through Clayfield College Council announced that construction will soon commence on our new Junior Schooling Building. This will be a much needed facility that will accommodate our Years 1-5 students in modern, spacious and well designed classrooms.

The plans for the Junior Schooling Building have been submitted to Brisbane City Council and a Development Application is in process. We are pleased that our consultant Architect is Archibett, and the project builder will be determined by a tender process. It is expected that this project will be constructed in approximately twelve months.

The \$6.5M project will commence in late 2009 and is being financially supported by a \$3M grant from the Australian Government through the 'Building the Education Revolution' program. The Clayfield College Foundation will contribute \$2.5M from bank borrowings and the remaining \$1M will need to be raised through an expected BGA grant and donations from the College community.

This is a wonderful opportunity for Clayfield College to respond to a strategically identified intention in our College vision. I commend this project to our Clayfield community and seek your support in bringing our new Junior Schooling Building to life.
